

Captains meeting 26/11/2024

- Are we able to kick off the barrier? Yes, but can't hold onto the barrier.
- Dangerous flick? Advice is to check the intention of the person flicking and intention of the person being hit. Any area of the body. Up to the discretion of the **WR & CR**.
- Concussion protocol – read and acknowledge this protocol. For the safety of the players. If in doubt – ask someone else. Medics will be present to assist. Make everyone aware of this before clubs.
- Tournament specific rules – nothing different from CMAS.
- Referee guidelines – referee/official abuse includes timekeepers/scorers/CR/WR.
- 15 minutes per half – no extra time in round robin.
- Referee time-out can be called to confirm any calls.
- Playing area entry 5 mins before game starts.
- Warm up area – please shower before getting into pool to minimize the visibility problems.
- Please vacate the area after games – **captains and coaches only** in the pool to observe games in progress.
- In water subbing only – do not touch lane ropes
- CR sign score sheet after games plus the score sheet (white & black teams).
- Draw queries ?? no issues raised.
- A & B league round robin. Relegation after that top of B league to A leagues.
- Semi finals only on Saturday.
- Friday referees will be appointed at the end of Thursday and the same on Saturday.
- Josh?? **Penalties at round robins – yes clock stops and play restarts at reset.**
- Roger? demerit points on programme? Clarify this please Jack – official abuse R500 to player and pay before the next game. Referee duties – not reporting R500.No points will be lost – makes no difference (demerits will not apply).
- Prize giving at the pool after final game has been completed.
- Wesley – beach access is fine. Returning players please shower to wash off sand and sunscreen before the games. Visibility will be affected.
- Metal drains at halfway point and in corners of the west side of the pool – not flush drains. Do not affect the game play.
- Please bring sunscreen – wear a lot and rinse off before games.
- Warm up pool before games.

- Municipality will supply gazebo's and umbrellas. Grass area available to first-come-first-serve basis. Take them down in the afternoon. Kept in the referee office after games finish. Stretch tent from Jo'burg from Kevin.
- Municipality will cordon off a section of the parking – ask car guards to move cones.
- **24-hour security at the pool** – ladies will only admit uwh players and spectators. Public area – see through fences. Watch out for pick pockets or guys looking to steal items from bags.
- **Friday night social @ DUC** – coloured arm bands will be given out in the team packs for club access **R55** for a boerewors role and salads per person.
- Cash or EFT & Durban will settle the bill – players to pay on Thursday or Friday. Coloured wrist bands will be supplied. Cash bar on site + extra food can be ordered.
- **Final function @ Crusaders sports club.**
- Welcome pack – **green (over 18 - alcohol)** **blue (under 18's non-alcohol)**
- TUKS – access to parking and pool??? Wrist bands (paper bands might not last)
- Issue captains with a pass?? Suggest taking a picture to send on WhatsApp to captains to show to parking guards? Yes, this makes sense.
- Sunscreen – non oily please rinse off before the games.
- TUKS – Whatsapp banking details on captains' group or pay in cash at pool.
- Jeanie – team captains to send Jeanie the numbers of under 18's in each team.
- Roger -? cover braai social in entry fee. Numbers and pool venue change meant that the social could not be covered by DUC.
