August 18	Roster submission - All players must be invited by now
September 1	Team submissions All roster invites accepted, player info and verification complete. Team seeding with input from club leaders
September 22	Schedule and draw announced
September 26	Pool set up 2-6PM – We would like 2 volunteers per team for the Friday set-up
September 27-28	CTCs! Approximate pool times: Saturday 8AM-6PM, Sunday 8AM-6PM

REGISTRATION:

1. Register your team on the [UWHPortal](#). To do this, sign in and then navigate to the event page. Click on “Register a team” and follow the prompts.
 - Once you have registered your team, you can invite players to your roster.
 - Please send any questions regarding team creation and roster building to support@atlantissports.org. (Gillian will be able to help you with some basic troubleshooting but doesn't have super admin power.)
 - Note: All rosters will be verified to confirm legitimacy of club teams. Players who do not meet the club rules may still meet the waiver criteria, just send us a message.
2. Pay your team fees.
 - A) \$1850 USD if you supply 2 volunteers for wall set-up on Friday
 - B) \$1950 USD team entry fee (opt out of wall set-up)(both include the \$100 deposit)

Includes an UWH tournament, snacks on the pool deck, Tournament keepsake and a chance to go head-to-head against other clubs!

 - A \$100 non-refundable deposit secures your team's spot
 - Registrations - No late or ref opt out fees.

We will be using PayPal for team fees. Please indicate in your transaction which team you are paying for. Teams are responsible for covering any fees associated with their choice of payment method. If you need an alternate payment method, please reach out to Gillian.

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TOURNAMENT TIMES:

Friday pool set up	2 – 6PM
Saturday	8AM – 6PM
Sunday	8AM – 6PM

The schedule for this event is designed to avoid early mornings and late nights, limiting the number of spots available but allowing all teams an evening out in Vegas.

TOURNAMENT FORMAT:

Right now, we expect to be able to host 12 teams across two courts with at least 12/15-minute halves which facilitates an optimal tournament experience

The tournament format will be pre-seeded pods followed by a full playoff format. All clubs will be ranked based on their rosters, to keep the competition balanced and engaging. If your club is bringing two squads, you can still make them as A & B teams or even teams and we will place them accordingly. Our goal is to avoid large goal differentials and ensure close, competitive games.

POOL DETAILS:

The pool address is: 8275 Spring Mountain Rd, Las Vegas, NV 89117, USA

The Desert Breeze pool is 25 yards wide x 50m pool that is 7'6" deep, smooth concrete

The tournament puck will be the canam uni2.

TEAM COMPOSITION

Both USOA and CUGA are currently trying to define how they categorize a club, but it will almost certainly be some form of geographical based format. The following document outlines the expectations of team composition. I am happy to chat about exception waivers to help any club wanting to enter a team but also ensure that the outcome of the event is in doubt.

Players who do not have a club can send us a message and we will find them a spot if available.

REFEREES:

- Refs are mucho expensive so to keep costs in check, we are planning to use the Team referee system with some timing help by our fantastic volunteers.
- Whole teams will be assigned games to referee and must supply the water refs, deck ref, timer and score keeper for the game. Every effort will be made to minimize the impacts to teams while ensuring distributed reffing.
- There will be no referee opt-out this year
- We are currently looking for and offering a small honorarium for a chief referee. Please email any of the organizers if this interests you or someone you know.

LOGISTICS:

- Harry Reid International Airport is the primary airport in the area.
- There are several lodging options both on and off the Las Vegas strip.
- The pool is ~20 minute drive from the Las Vegas strip.

CUGA/USOA REGISTRATION:

- All players should be 2025 USOA/CUGA members
- We will be using the UWHPortal to verify player USOA/CUGA statuses.

TOURNAMENT MANAGEMENT:

We are happy to feature the complete Atlantis Sports time/score management system to provide up to date integration with <https://uwportal.com/>. At this point we are not expecting to provide video coverage of the tournament.

WITHDRAWAL REFUNDS:

Should you need to withdraw your team, the following refunds will be provided.

- Up until August 1, 2025; Your entry fee will be returned minus the \$100 deposit and any transfer fees.
- Up until August 15, 2025; a partial refund of \$500USD will be provided
- Up until September 1, 2025; a partial refund of \$175USD will be provided.

AWARDS: Will be presented poolside at the conclusion of the tournament.

POOL SET UP / TAKE DOWN:

- We hope that every team sends some help for pool set up and have included a small honorarium to each team that helps.
- Teams participating in the final game on either court are kindly expected to dismantle the court.
