We are pleased to announce the continuation of the Women's Tournament Scholarship Fund for 2026! The Scholarship Fund is to help subsidize expenses for promising and dedicated women across the country who would not otherwise be able to attend the Tournament.

Scholarships up to \$200 (plus waived tournament fees) will be awarded to up to three tournament attendees based on the criteria listed below.
