We are planning on using 1 playing area to accommodate up to 8 teams, which facilitates an optimal tournament experience. (If we have 12+ teams interested, we will look to add a 2^{nd} court).

This OC Cup will have 1 competitive grade with no age or gender restrictions:

• Open (a second grade may be added if we expand to 2 courts)

TEAM ELIGIBILITY:

Important note: The OC Cup will be a club-only tournament. Non-Club teams can be accepted following national championship team rules and with approval by tournament organizers.

What does this mean?

- For a team to be eligible for playoffs and medals, all members of the team must be members of the same club, i.e. registered with their federation (e.g. CUGA or USOA) under that club as of Jan 31st 2025.
- If a player has a legitimate reason to change clubs and join one of the attending teams between Jan 31st and OC CUP, they may send an email to Orangeuwh@gmail.com, and make a request to change clubs. Their request will be evaluated based on legitimacy of reason to change clubs, which include but is not limited to:
- Moving for work or school with providing proof of hiring or registration
- Moving for other personal reasons with providing proof of permanent / long term stay (rental agreement, change in driver's license...)

Note: Regional directors might be contacted to confirm legitimacy of club teams.

What if my team has some players from another club? Can we still play?

- YES. But you will not be eligible to play in the playoffs, once the round robin is over your team won't have any more games. We may, if enough non-eligible teams register, hold separate playoffs to offset the number of games missed (but we can't guarantee this) or perhaps have a set of potluck games where the remaining teams are mixed up and formed into new teams. This is subject to change based upon the number of registered teams and per discretion of the tournament organizers and team captains.
- If we have more than 8 teams (and less than 12) by the standard registration deadline, then priority will be given to club teams from the SW, NW and Western Canada. Club teams from outside of these regions will be given secondary priority, followed by non-club teams from any region.
- Confirmation of your team's spot will come by Feb 4th.

IMPORTANT DETAILS: Registration Dates, Times, and Costs

- Registration opens: Saturday, January 4th at 10am Pacific Time,
 - Standard Registration: \$1500 (including a \$100 deposit)
 - A \$100 non-refundable deposit can secure your teams spot, pending full payment by the fee deadline. Pending availability, submitting this fee secures your team's spot.
 - Registrations are on a first-paid basis.
 - Late Registration: \$1700 after Jan 31st.
 - Full payments must be received by Saturday, Feb 7th at midnight Pacific time.

- Please send as friend/family (deposit/payment only counts if the full value is received). Teams are responsible for covering any fees associated with their choice of payment method.
- Rosters to be finalized by Saturday, FEB 14th at Midnight Pacific time.
 - This includes ensuring all your team's members have accepted their invites and completed their USOA/CUGA registration for 2025 and accounts linked on UWH Portal.

REGISTRATION DETAILS:

To register your team visit www.uwhportal.com, sign in, and then navigate to the event page. Click on "Register a team" and follow the prompts. The only information required to make a team is a team name (can be edited later). All other team information can be added/edited later. Once you have registered your team, your players can request to be added to your team, or you can invite them to your roster. Please send any questions regarding team creation and roster building to support@atlantissports.org. Once you have registered your team on www.uwhportal.com please send in your \$100 deposit (or full entry fee if you are confident in attending). If your completed entry fee is not received within 1 week your team will be removed from the team list to make room for other teams and you will have to re-apply (space allowing). If you need to withdraw, your entry fee will be returned minus the \$100 deposit and any transfer fees.

Please note your Team Registration includes:

UWH tournament, snacks on pool deck, Tournament keepsake, Saturday Social dinner, a chance for the CUP and all the Gatorade you can drink!

This year we will be using the Team referee system; This means that whole teams will be assigned games to referee and must supply 3 water refs, timer and score keeper(5 individuals). There will not be any referee opt-outs for this tournament.

TOURNAMENT MANAGEMENT AND VIDEO: We are happy to feature the Atlantis Sports Time and Score Systems and schedule integration with UWHPortal.com. At this point we are not expecting to provide video coverage of the tournament.
